- promoting equal access to high standards of specialist care, treatments, drugs, clinical trials, research opportunities, infrastructure and funding, internationally.

The fees for the first year will be 50€ for regular members (i.e. scientists and clinicians working in any field related to mitochondria and paying an active membership fee) and 25 for junior (i.e. undergraduate students above 18 years of age, PhD students, clinicians in training and postdocs) and senior members (i.e. previous active members after their retirement from full-time academic or clinical employment).

We all look forward to meeting you at the next Euromit 2023 in Bologna, Italy. Registered members will receive a 50€ discount towards the registration costs of Euromit 2023, during which time we will hold the first official meeting of E-Mit and carry out elections for the Executive Board.
